

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY SITUATION ON THE 3RD STREET CORRIDOR BETWEEN 7TH AVENUE AND 13TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, by letter dated January 26, 2021, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Works has informed this City Council that unsafe conditions exist at the 3rd Street corridor between 7th Avenue and 13th Avenue, which is causing severe sewage backups to the residents in that area; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid requires purchase and installation of a pump by-pass system for the sewer line; and

WHEREAS, public property and the peace, health, safety and welfare of the City's inhabitants are affected by the conditions existing at the 3rd Street corridor between 7th Avenue and 13th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 73 of the City Charter the City Council is making a finding of Public Emergency, requiring immediate action which cannot await competitive bidding; and by this ordinance, permitting the waiver of bids and designating the Department of Public Works to perform such work as is necessary due to such public emergency; NOW, THEREFORE,

The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened does hereby ordain and enact:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares that the 3rd Street corridor between 7th Avenue and 13th Avenue is an emergency situation, which is unsafe, dangerous and jeopardizes the health, welfare and safety of the City's inhabitants, thereby creating a public emergency, which requires immediate attention.

Section 2. Pursuant to Section 73 of the Charter of the City of Mount Vernon and Section 103 of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, the competitive bidding requirement is hereby waived for the purchase and installation of a pump by-pass system.

Section 3. The Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to purchase an emergency pump by-pass system (one (1) Generac 6-inch mobile trash pump) from Hudson Machinery LLC at a cost not to exceed \$59,833.00 and the Department of Public Works is hereby designated as the agency charged with having said repairs carried out.


Section 4. Funds for the aforesaid not to exceed \$59,833.00 are available from 2020FY - Environmental Protection (EPA) Budget Line - Axxx.xxx.


Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Board of Estimate and Contract.


