

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE WESTCHESTER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SENIOR PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 18, 2021, the Commissioner of the Department of Recreation has requested legislation authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services under the Title IIIC-1 and IIIC-2 HDC2-FFRC Act program for the contract period March 20, 2020 through September 30, 2021 and IIIC-1/IIIC-2 HDC3-CARES Act Program for the contract period April 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021; NOW, THEREFORE,

The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services under the Title IIIC-1 and IIIC-2 HDC2-FFRC Act program for the contract period March 20, 2020 through September 30, 2021 and IIIC-1/IIIC-2 HDC3-CARES Act Program for the contract period April 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

Section 2. Funds for the Title IIIC-1 and IIIC-2 are to be deposited in Revenue Code A4803.1 to provide for an appropriation in Budget Codes A6774.104, A6774.476 and A6773.104.

Section 3. There is no cost to the City for Title IIIC-1 & IIIC-2 (Nutrition). The total budget is in the amount of \$103,508.00, HDC2-FFRC Act \$21,940, and HDC3-CARES Act \$81,568.00.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Board of Estimate and Contract.



AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH CITIZEN OBSERVER, LLC FOR THE TIP 411.

WHEREAS, by letter dated February 26, 2021, the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety has requested legislation authorizing the Mayor to enter into a renewal agreement with Citizen Observer, LLC for the Tip 411; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid agreement will allow civilians to text information anonymously to the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid agreement will commence February 2021 through January 2022 at a cost not to exceed \$5,000.00; NOW, THEREFORE,

The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Citizen Observer, LLC for the Tip 411.





The City of Mount Vernon, in City Council convened, does hereby ordain and enact:






